**THE PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS (LICENSING OF PREMISES AND BUSSINESS)
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2006**

CONDITIONS FOR LICENSING PEST CONTROL OPERATORS (PCOs)

1. Trained personnel (detailed CV's).
2. List of all products used and source (supply company).
3. Rates (quantity/area), methods of application and where applied (e.g. homes, hotels, offices e.t.c.).
4. Types and state of protective clothing (e.g. respirators, helmets, gumboots, overalls e.t.c.).
5. First aid measures to be taken in cases of accidents (first aid kit with relevant anti-dotes).
6. Safety measures to protect people in the buildings, food stuffs (during and after operations).
7. Types of equipments, their conditions and servicing (sprayers, fire extinguishers, fumigation sheets, sand snakes e.t.c.).

8. Letter of commitment to supply restricted products (from the registrant/ agent upon issuance of a licence to applicant).
9. Applicant makes a write up on the above requirements and fills Form A1 and then submits to the PCPB office.
10. Application fees only received after fulfillment of the above conditions.
11. An inspection is then conducted to ascertain the information provided and a report made that recommends issuance of a licence or identifies defects and gives Recommendations for their rectification.
12. A licence is issued to those recommended for licensing.
13. A licence so issued is valid for a calendar year and renewed annually.
